This paper looks at changing living arrangements in Queensland. We will look at how living arrangements have changed over the 15 years to 2001 using specially formulated tables from the last three censuses. These trends have, in turn, been used to determine household projections, which indicate considerable variation in the ways that people are expected to live together in the future.
